WHO? Children entering Kindergarten in Fall 2018

Child must be 5 years old on or before August 15, 2018 and will be entering kindergarten in a **Washington County** school in the fall.

WHAT? Kindergarten registration

Please bring to the school:

- Tennessee Immunization Certificate/physical form (dated within one year prior to the time the child will enter school)
- Child's Social Security card
- Official birth certificate (If the child was born in TN and you don't have a birth certificate, you may get one at the Washington County Health Department for a small fee. Call 975-2200 for an appointment.)
- Proof of residence address (e.g., utility bill)

You need to bring the information you have in order to get the Kindergarten registration started so your child will be ready to begin school in the fall.

WHEN? Thursday, February 15.....Between the hours of 3:00 - 6:00 pm
Thursday, March 8.....Between the hours of 3:00 - 6:00 pm

No registration held if schools are closed due to inclement weather.

WHERE?

You should bring the above information to the **Washington County** elementary school nearest the child's home. You may find your child's school of residence on the wcde.org homepage under Parents & Students link - Find Your School Zone. These schools include Boones Creek Elem., Fall Branch, Grandview, Gray, Jonesborough Elem., Lamar, Ridgeview, South Central, Sulphur Springs, and West View. You will be asked to complete some student information and have all your forms verified during registration. You will then be given an appointment to bring your child back to the school in the Spring for an educational screening. If you have questions, please call 434-4923 or 753-1100.
