- 1 primary journal (half-page ruled) (bound, not spiral)
- 1-inch 3-ring binder with inside pockets in front and back (Little, McInturff and Carpenter –plastic 3- prong folder with pockets instead)
- 1 additional plastic 3-prong folder with pockets
- 1 pencil pouch with zipper (clear front- to be used in notebook or folder-not for pencils)
- 1 pack of highlighters
- Headphones or earbuds
