Dear Families,

Boones Creek Middle School is on an EPIC! journey. Why EPIC!? Through this empowering program, all educational stakeholders (faculty, staff, students, families and community members) will come together as one acknowledging our students' happiness, safety and well-being as our highest priority! As an integral part of this EPIC! journey, we want to encourage our youth to be respectful, responsible, trustworthy, confident individuals who reach their highest potential.

Keeping this goal in mind, we have made a purposeful effort to provide our students with opportunities to be rewarded for their positive efforts both academically and behaviorally. We wanted to make certain you had a copy of our expectations and the reward trips our teachers are planning so you can encourage EPIC! behavior from your students. The level of expectation for these reward trips increases as we move through the school year. Based on our discipline plan for the school year, students can receive behavior marks for inappropriate behaviors, being unprepared for class, being disrespectful, and so forth. In order to qualify for the EPIC! Reward Trip for each nine weeks grading period the following expectations apply:


- **For the first nine weeks**, it is our expectation that students receive **six marks or less** for the grading period. Students may have **no more than one detention hall**. Students must have good attendance, being present 90% or more of the time is also required. If any students meet these requirements, they will be eligible to participate in a fun day at Fender's Farm located in Jonesborough, Tennessee.
- **For the second nine weeks**, it is our expectation that students receive **three marks or less** for the grading period. Students must have **not been assigned any detention halls**. Students must have good attendance, being present 90% or more of the time is also required. If students meet these requirements, they will be eligible to go snow tubing at Jonas Ridge in Jonas Ridge, North Carolina.
- **For the third nine weeks**, it is our expectation that students receive **three marks or less** for the grading period. Students must have **not been assigned any detention halls**. Students must have good attendance, being present 90% or more of the time is also required. If students meet these requirements, they will be eligible to go spend their day at Quantum Leap and viewing a movie at Reel to Reel Theatre. Both are located in Johnson City, Tennessee.
- **For the fourth nine weeks**, it is our expectation that students receive **three marks or less** for the grading period. Students must have **not been assigned any detention halls**. Students must have good attendance, being present 90% or more of the time is also required. If students meet these requirements, they will be eligible to spend an extended day at Camp Explore held on the campus of the Clyde Austin 4-H Center in Greeneville, Tennessee.

We hope that these activities will be an added incentive for our students to strive to be their very BEST!
