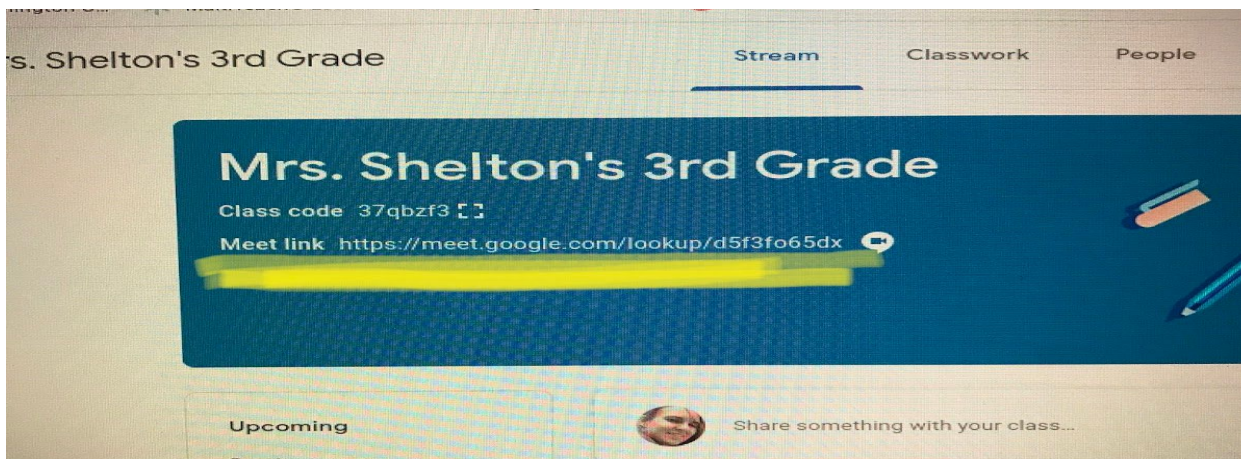


Mrs. Shelton's Daily Meet Schedule

Recorded Math, RTI, and Reading lessons will be posted to the stream daily.

My goal is to have all the students work on Google Slides assigned daily. The students will click on Monday and be prompted to fill out the attendance sheet. Then will be assigned a writing assignment. Then be prompted to go to the Related Arts google classroom to check for their daily assignment/activity. Then back to the google slide for math with a math warm-up to be done independently, then join the google meet for our math lesson that will be in the slideshow. Students can work on it early if wanted and then be ready to ask questions for where he/she is stuck during the lesson. Then the slideshow will progress students through the normal day with a reminder to eat lunch, go to RTI for a lesson/activity, and take an educational break. Students will then have a Science/Social Studies activity on the slideshow(this week ways to be a good citizen in the classroom). Followed by a reminder of our Reading Meet with slides for the day's lesson. Then students will be congratulated for doing their work and will have a reminder of everything he/she should have completed that day. When finished students will go back into the classwork area of google classroom and mark as done the day's slideshow assignment. My goal in doing the daily slideshow is to have everything in one place and students can go through the day as quickly or slowly as he/she needs to.
