### TCAP/TNREADY TESTING

Thank you to our students incredible patience and hard work on the TCAP/ TNReady assessments. These assessments help provide a glimpse of where our students are and where we need to focus instruction the following year. Rules governing tests in grades 2-8 are found in Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA 49-1-617).

### FIELD DAY

### 6th GRADE PARENTS
