

Learning Support for Students in Quarantine

In the 2021-22 school year, some students will need to be remote for periods of time due to quarantine or illness. Relationships are essential. Keeping students with adults and classmates they know supports academic and social-emotional learning.

When students need temporary remote instruction, here is the learning support you can expect.

Individual Quarantine

- **How students will learn**
 - May include one or **both** of the following:
 - Student logs in **Google Classroom(PreK-8th)/Canvas(9th-12th)** for assignments and independent learning
 - Student logs in **Google Classroom (PreK-8th)/Canvas(9th-12th)** to view live and/or recorded lessons
- **How students will be supported**
 - May include one or **both** of the following:
 - Students will have access to their teacher & class at designated times during the school day
 - Students will have access to designated office hours

Classroom Quarantine

- **How students will learn**
 - May include one or **both** of the following:
 - Student logs in **Google Classroom(PreK-8th)/Canvas(9th-12th)** for assignments and independent learning
 - Student logs in **Google Classroom(Prek-8th)/Canvas(9th-12th)** to view live and/or recorded lessons
- **How students will be supported**
 - Students will follow the class schedule issued from their teacher
 - Students will have access to live and recorded classroom instruction
 - Students will have access to designated office hours

School Quarantine

- **How students will learn**
 - Same as classroom quarantine
- **How students will be supported**
 - Same as classroom quarantine
